CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

The selection committee will evaluate each applicant according to criteria established by the Kansas City Chapter National Electrical Contractors Association. The criteria generally focus on a combination of the student's academic merit (as exhibited by the student's GPA, ACT or SAT score, and essay answer), financial need, employment and community involvement, as shown below. The personal data listed on the front sheet will not be furnished to the selection committee, so it is a blind selection process. Financial information will not be furnished with applicant's identity to the review committee in the blind selection process and will not be shared with any NECA members.

- Academic performance 10 %
- GPA 10%
- ACT/SAT 10%
- Community service/school activities 10%
- Employment 10%
- Field of study 20%
- Essay 10%
- Financial need 20%

Applicant must be pursuing a Bachelor or higher degree program in a full-time program at an accredited college or university that is applicable to the Electrical Construction Industry.
